Drive toward the south side of the lot and you will see a double-door entrance into the school. That is the entrance you need to use. If the door is locked when you get there, you will see a buzzer just to the right side of the doors. Push the buzzer and someone will come to let you inside.

We meet in the Library (room 201). The Library is directly ahead (west) down the hallway and on your right side (north side).

There is no cost to attend these WHNA Neighbors Meetings.
